SEABROOK SEEDERS

Seabrook Seeders are an easy to use and simple pasture seeding machine available in drawn units and for mounting to existing implements, like dozer rippers, blade ploughs, off sets and chisel ploughs.

Seabrook Seeders are suitable for broad area application of pasture and fodder crop seeds such as forage and silk sorghum, cowpea and grasses including Rhodes and Buffle etc.

The seeding mechanism uses a rotating agitator in the base of the seed bin that passes over a sliding adjustable aperture opening. By adjusting the opening the rate of seed application is varied.

The seeder is divided into separate compartments, each compartment has an individual seed rate adjustment so different seeds and rates can be used in each compartment. A gauge setting tool is provided to aid the setting of the single line of openings across the machine. The larger compartments are for grass and grains etc, and smaller compartments at 900mm spacing are for use with fine seeds (e.g. legumes etc.). All compartments have a swinging baffle system that swings down for use with heavy seeds (grain seeds etc.) and swung away when using light grass seed (E.g.: buffle grass etc.).

A large lid opening makes filling with fluffy grass seed simple and a weatherproof bin keeps seed dry (no need to tarp up).

With special seed cup attachments, mounted boxes can deliver seed through tubes to implement tynes, for example to plant oats with a scarifier or cultivator.

Mounted Seabrook Seeders can be driven by means of an electric motor (usually for dozer mounting), hydraulic motor or ground driven.

Trailing Seabrook Seeders have a removable draw bar to allow for easier transportation. Machines are mounted on 14" tyres or can be supplied with 16" tyres (6 stud wheel) for extra ground clearance.

Tow points are provided at the rear of the seeder to pull covering harrows or tyre rollers.

Machines are available in standard widths from the 0.4m single outlet box for mounting to ripper tynes etc up to 5.4m wide. Custom built sizes are also available.

As part of a good pasture establishment consider a Seabrook Seeder for a simple to use and effective means of broad area seeding.
